


## Managing hierarchy sets

Create own view for customization.

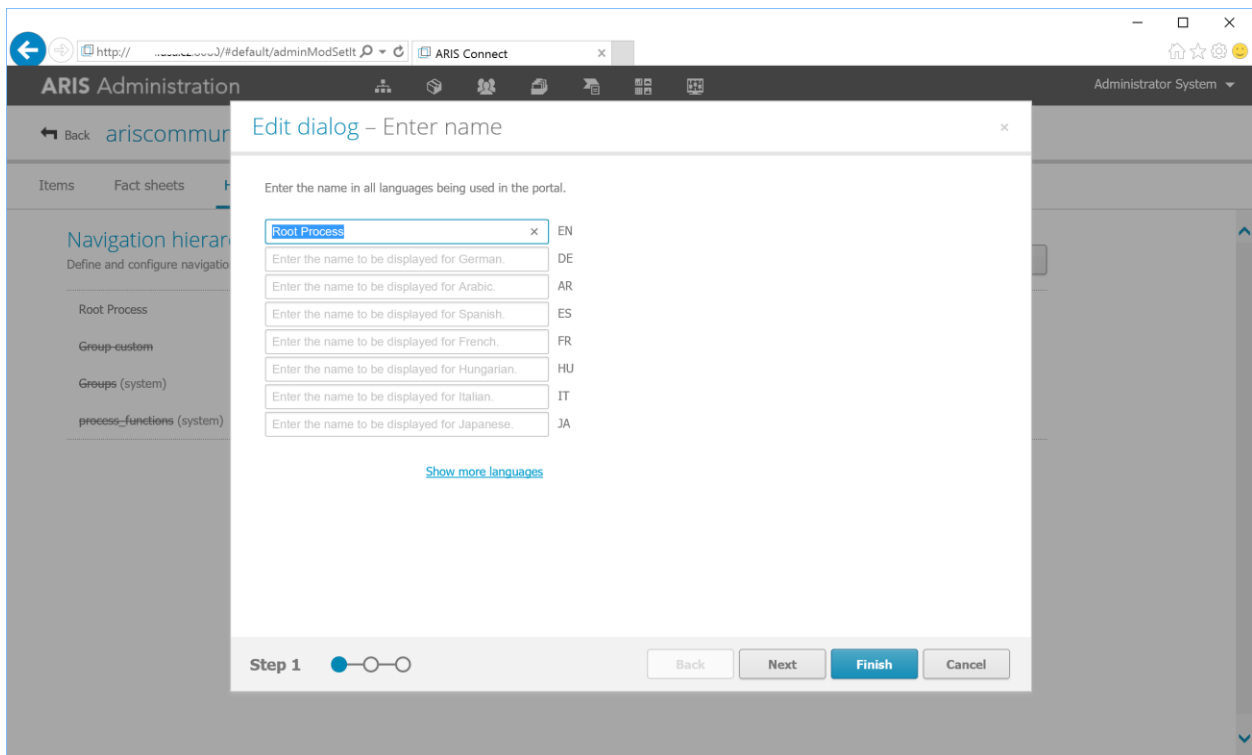
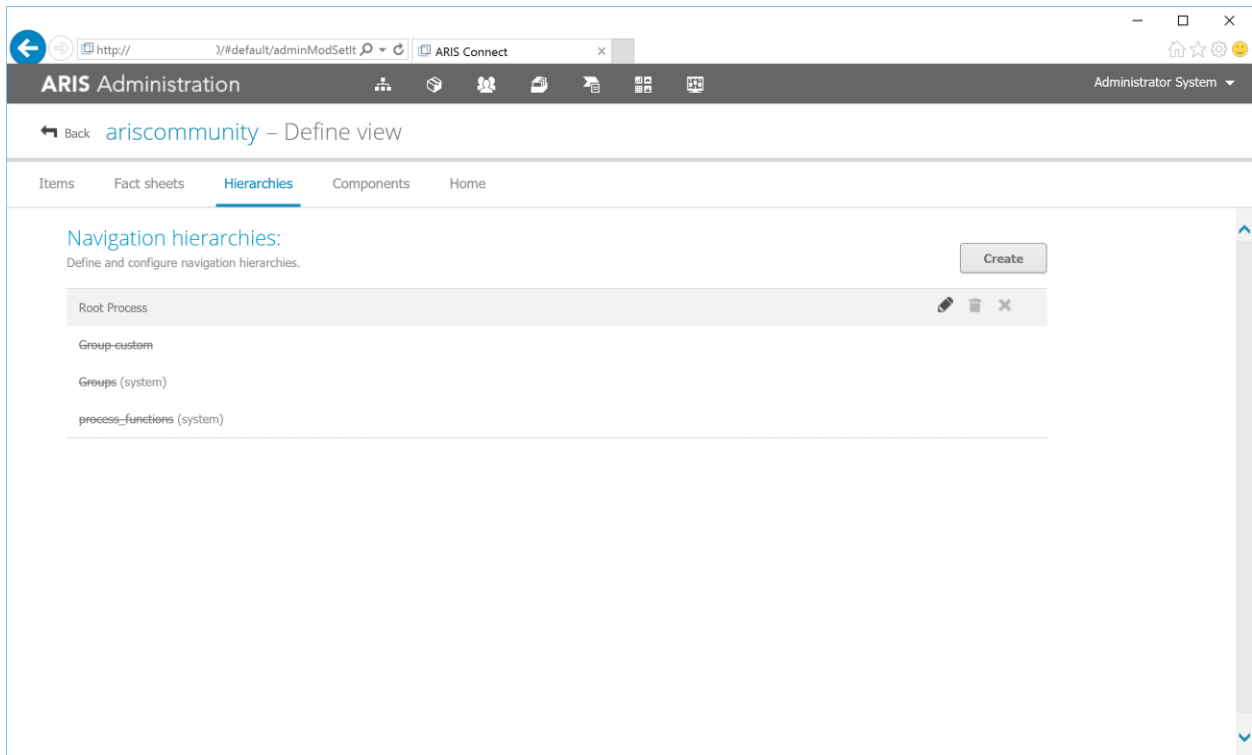

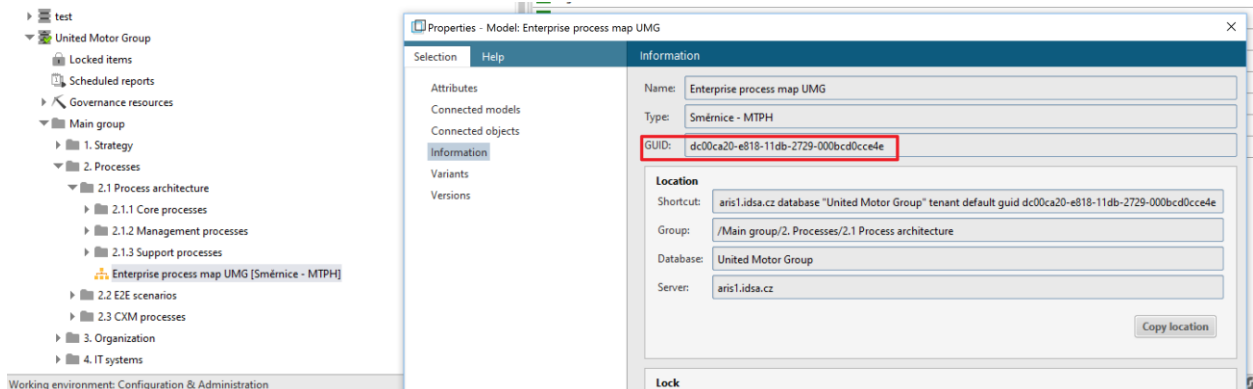


Create Hierarchy Structure, it could be for example by process, Chain, Organizational Unites, Groups..

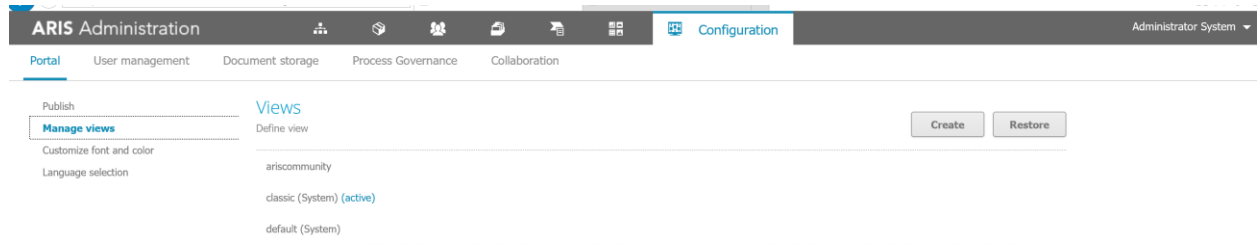
